Display size

The texts of content in this site have a relative font size, that is to say expandable according to the needs.

To change the display size of the text:

- Mozilla Firefox, Microsoft Edge and Google Chrome: press CTRL + plus sign (+) to enlarge and CTRL + minus sign (-) to decrease. CTRL + zero of the numeric pad (0) to return to the default size.
- Safari: press Option + Command + minus sign (-) simultaneously
- Internet Explorer: go to View >> Text size and choose.

Aids to navigation – Skip links

This menu is placed at the beginning of the page, these links allow, as soon as it is loaded, to directly access the main areas of the site.

Aids to Navigation – ARIA Roles in Document Areas

You can use your technical help (screen reader, etc.) to move around the pages using roles. These roles allow you to better structure the document and thus help you in your navigation.

- > With NVDA: NVDA + F7
- > With Jaws: CTRL + INS + semicolon (;)
- > With VoiceOver: CTRL + Option + U
