## What are you doing on the TJV?

I am participating in the student regatta organized as part of the Transat Jacques Vabre. The race will take place on Thursday, November 4, and will consist of a course in the Eure basin: buoys will be set up so that the different crews can sail around them. A total of 16 student crews will participate on J80 type boats, lent by the Société des Régates and the SNPH, the sailing clubs of Le Havre.
