The Disability Department of the University of Le Havre Normandie aims to improve the everyday life of all students with disabilities by responding to their individual needs :

- Student welcome, information, and support
- Implementation of adapted courses, with the help of the Preventive Medicine Service
- Provision of a reception room
- Provision of appropriate facilities for exams
- Provision of appropriate equipment
- Liaison between the student, his/her family, and the teaching staff
- Integration of students with disabilities into campus life through cultural and sports activities
- Coordination with the local services dedicated to persons with disabilities
